**1 Organising Authority**

1.1 The organising authority for this event is Helensburgh Sailing Club.

**2 Rules**

2.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the Royal Yachting Association (RYA), and the class rules of the appropriate Class Association.

**3 Eligibility & Entry**

- 3.1 Entries should be made on the official entry form. This is available from the Club website page for this event, [www.helensburghsailingclub.co.uk](http://www.helensburghsailingclub.co.uk). Forms will also be available at Registration
- 3.2 Boats shall have a valid Portsmouth Yardstick or Class Certificate as appropriate.
- 3.3 The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry and/or to ask all or any boats to complete further undertakings or declarations before accepting any entry.
- 3.4 Competitors under sixteen must complete the appropriate sections on the entry form and have parent or guardian's signature of consent on the entry form.

**4 Fees**

**7 Responsibility & Insurance**

- 7.1 Competitors must have third party insurance of at least £2,000,000
- 7.2 RRS Fundamental Rule 4 states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone." This includes a decision whether or not to go afloat, and should take into account the equipment and clothing of both helm and crew.
- 7.3 The race organisers shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however caused, to the owner or crew as a result of their taking part in the event.

**8 Radio Communication**

- 8.1 A boat shall neither make radio transmissions whilst racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction includes mobile phones.

**9 Registration, Briefing, & Sailing Instructions**

- 9.1 Registration will take place at HSC Clubhouse from 10:00 am Saturday 14th August 2010.
- 9.2 There will be a competitors briefing at HSC on Sat 14th August June at 11.30 hrs.
- 9.3 Draft Sailing Instructions will be available on the Club website. Final Sailing Instructions will be available to competitors from the website after 10th August and at registration. Questions on the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions, should be in writing to the address shown on the entry form.

**10 Courses, Number of Races & Warning Signal**

- 10.1 Six races are scheduled for the event and may consist of a mix of Windward-Leeward and/or Triangle-Sausage
- 10.2 Subsequent races shall follow as soon as possible after the last competitor has finished the previous race.
- 10.3 The minimum number of races to constitute an event shall be 1 (one).
- 10.4 The warning signal will be 12:55 on Sat & 1055 on Sunday.
- 10.5 Each race will last approximately 60 minutes
- 10.6 No race shall start after 17.00 hours on Saturday , and 15:00 on Sunday

**11 Prize Giving**

- 11.1 Overall Prizes based on 20% of the entry will be presented as soon as possible after the last race on Sunday.

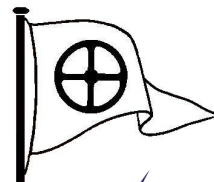
