1. Objectives

- 1. Helensburgh Sailing Club expects all members and their guests to show respect and understanding to each other, to treat everyone equally, and to conduct themselves in a way which reflects the ethos of the club as set out in the constitution.
- 2. Abusive, aggressive or discriminatory language or behaviour, or a lack of respect for other people and their property will not be tolerated. Misconduct should be reported to the committee and may lead to disciplinary action.
- 3. Helensburgh Sailing Club respects and supports the RYA Racing Charter and members are expected to sail in compliance with it.

2. Policy Statement

Members are expected to:

- Abide by club's rules and byelaws
- Observe and comply with club's policies and procedures
- Treat members and visitors with respect and understanding regardless of age, disability, gender identity, race, religion or belief, or sex / sexual identity
- Avoid the use of language which others may find offensive whether on club premises or using social media channels identified with the club
- Encourage all members to play as full a role in the club as they wish to, and to support them in developing their skills and experience
- Recognise the contribution of coaches, instructors, officials and volunteers
- Prioritise the safety and well-being of participants
- Promote courtesy to other water users
- Use established procedures in the resolution of any genuine concern or dispute

3. Implementation

- Members should feel welcome and valued, should be respected and treated fairly, and should be listened to and kept informed.
- Members should be involved and have the opportunity to contribute towards decision-making in the club.
